FBC Laramie is a good church in a great location. The church parsonage and facilties are located adjacent to the University of Wyoming campus. It has about 30k residents plus student enrollment. The previous pastor died serving the church, and the church is grieving this as well some conflict that followed. Current attendance is 25-40.

First Baptist Church of Laramie has a long history, over 150 years, rich in its contribution to the town and state as well as rich in its outreach of evangelism and ecumenical cooperation.
